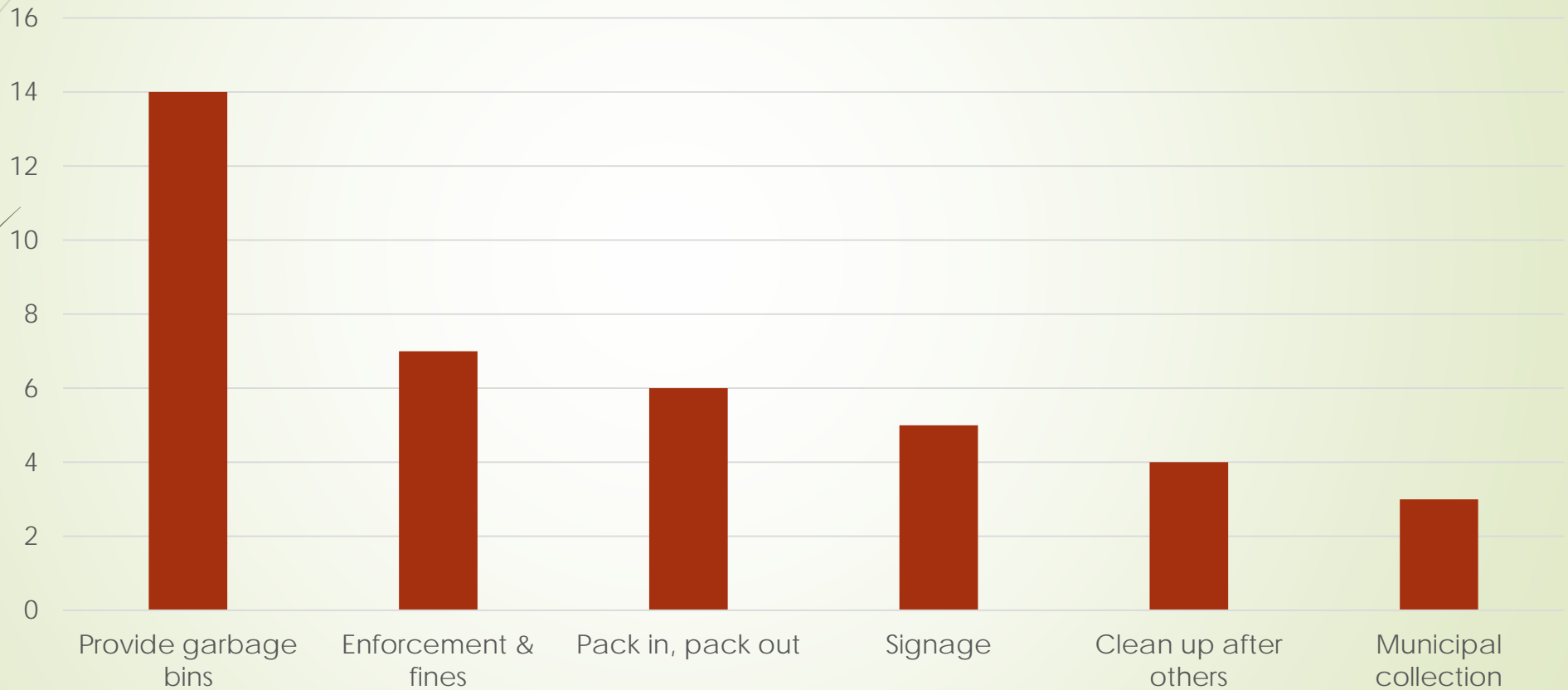


Findings: Space to Roost Striped Bass Angler Survey at the Guzzle

- ▶ 22 people completed the survey
 - ▶ 15 fish striped bass at the Guzzle
 - ▶ 5 fish striped bass at other locations in Nova Scotia
 - ▶ 2 declined to say where or if they fish striped bass

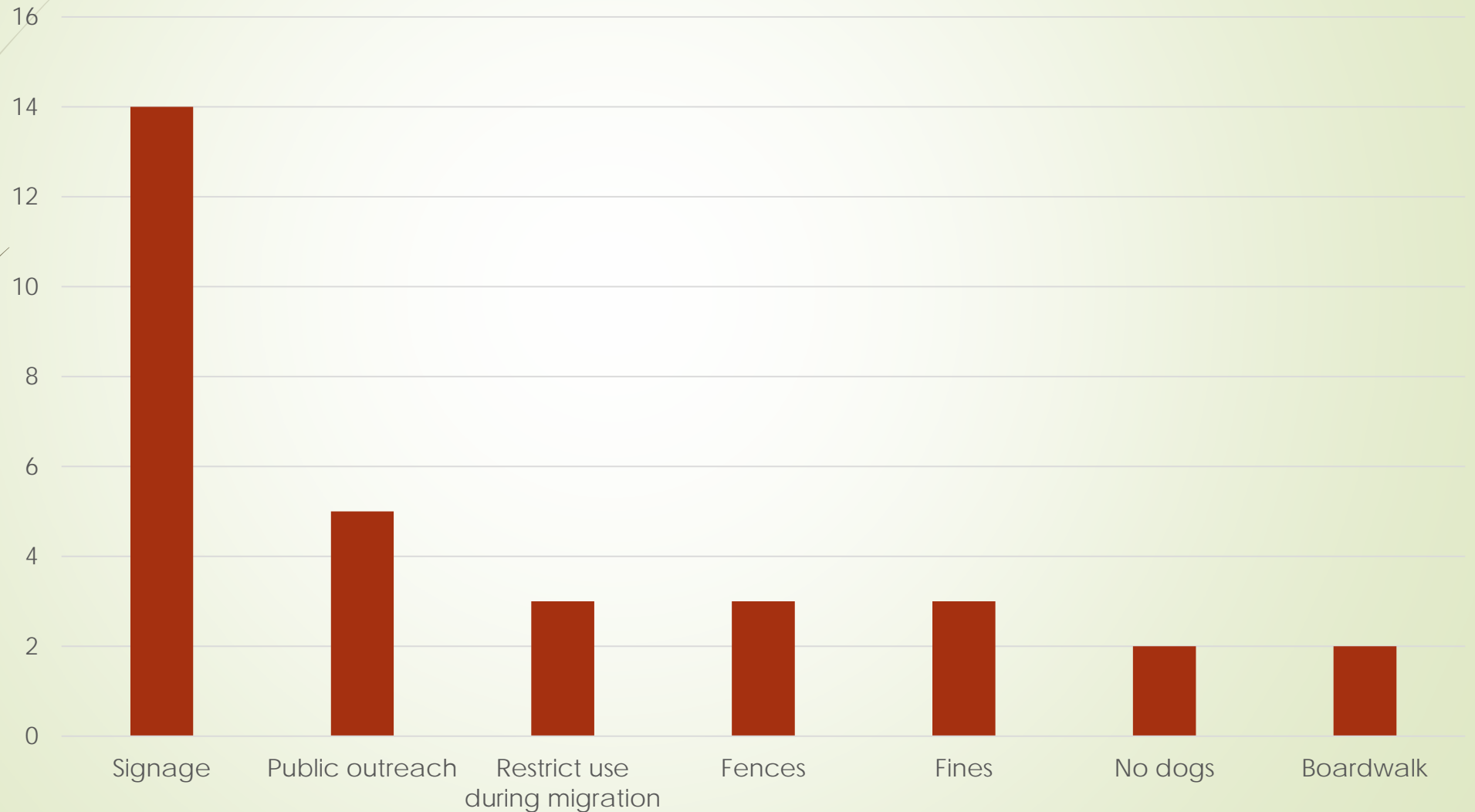
How can we keep the Guzzle free of garbage?

(answers from all survey respondents)



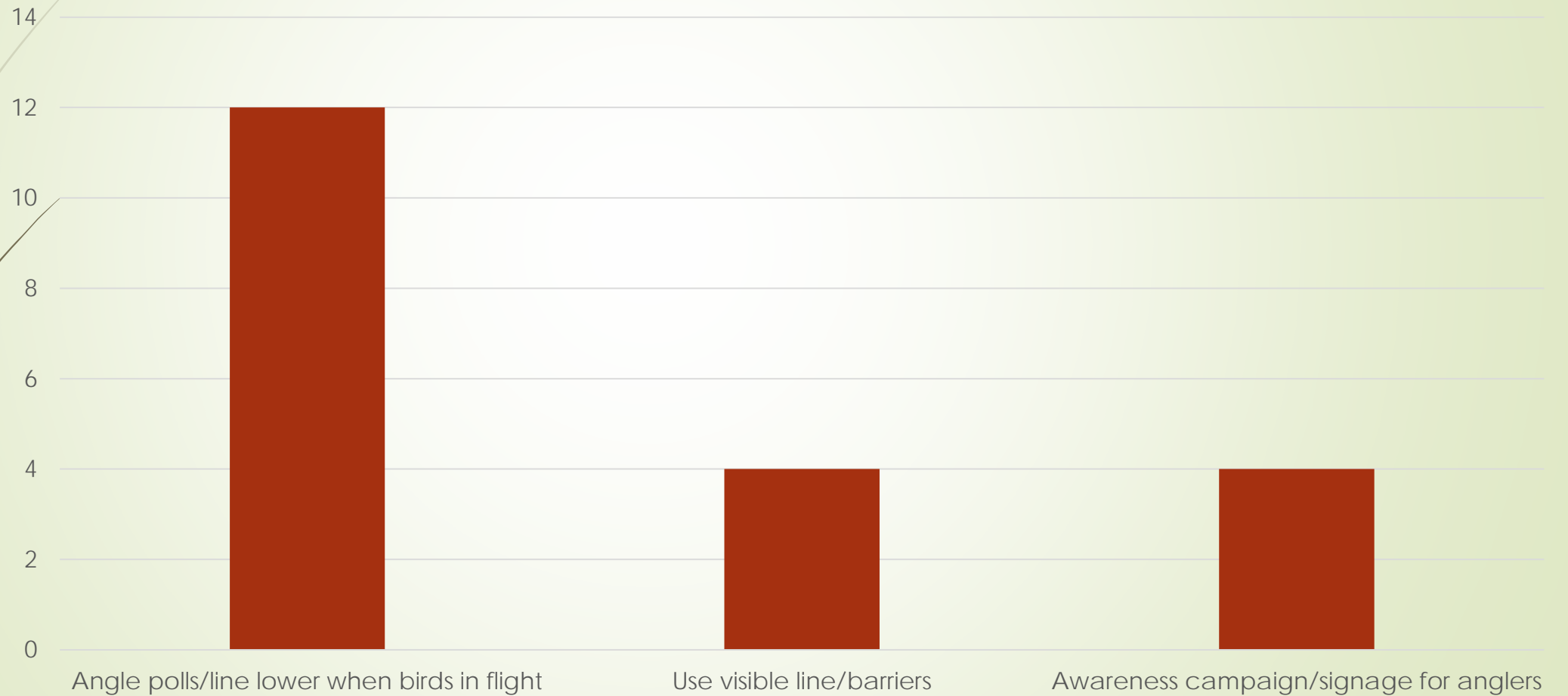
How can we communicate to beach users to keep away from resting shorebirds at high tide?

(answers from all survey respondents)



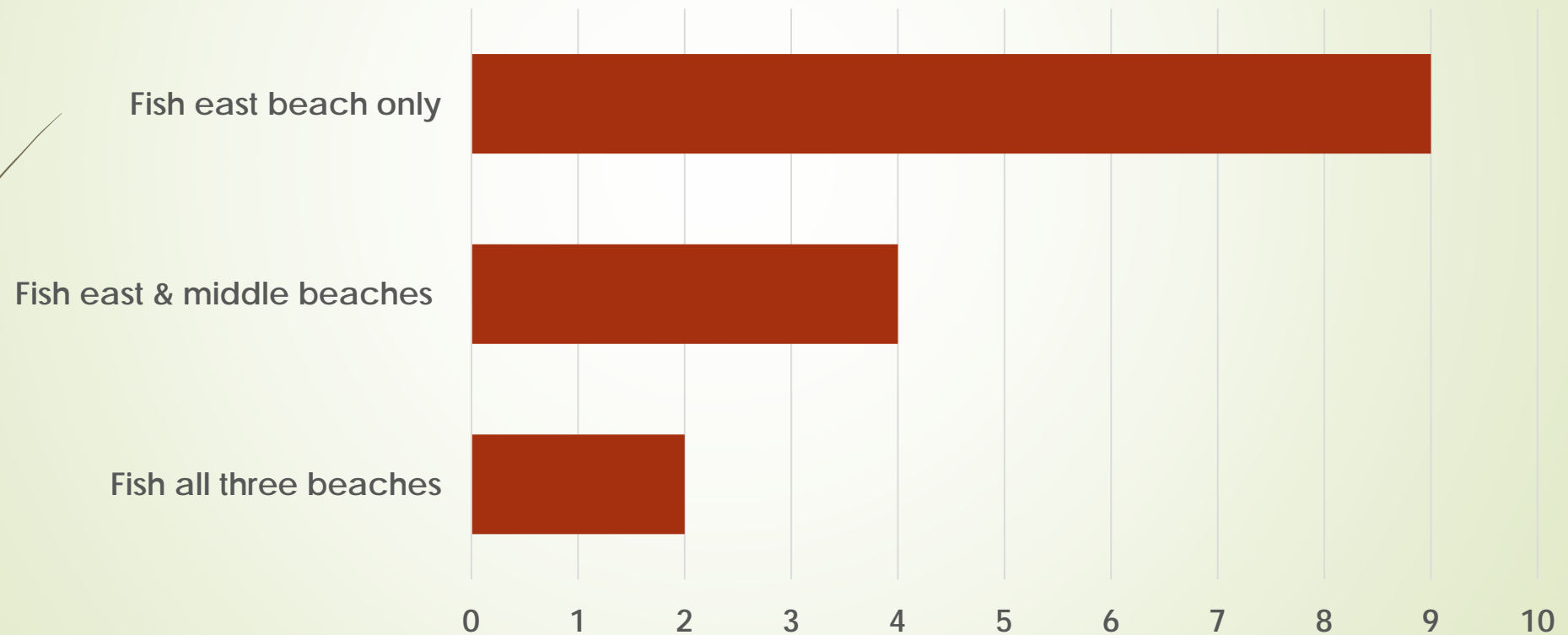
Suggestions on how to prevent shorebirds from hitting fishing lines

(answers only from respondents who fish at the Guzzle)





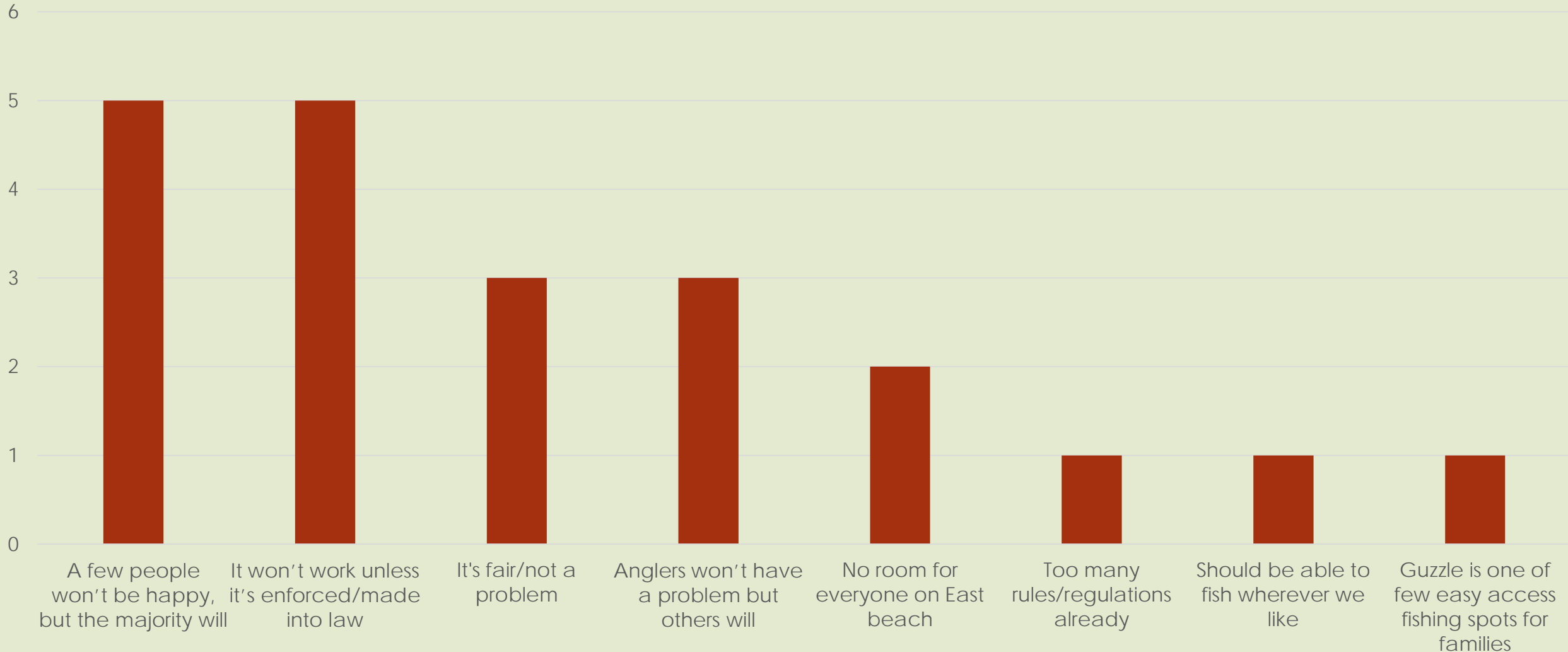
Do you foresee problems with asking anglers to fish only on certain beaches at the Guzzle two hours before and after high tide in August?

(answers from all survey respondents)



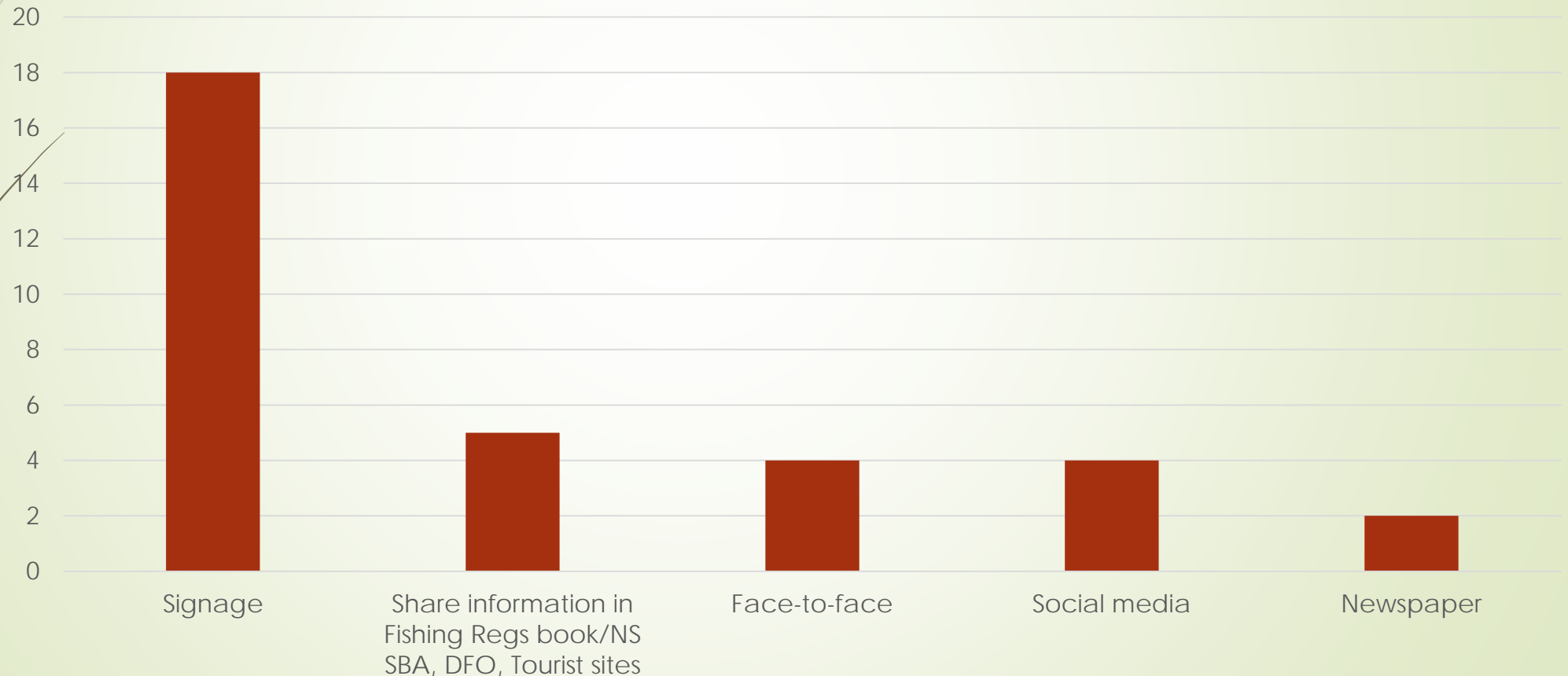
What problems do you foresee asking anglers to only fish on certain beaches at the Guzzle?

(answers from all survey respondents)



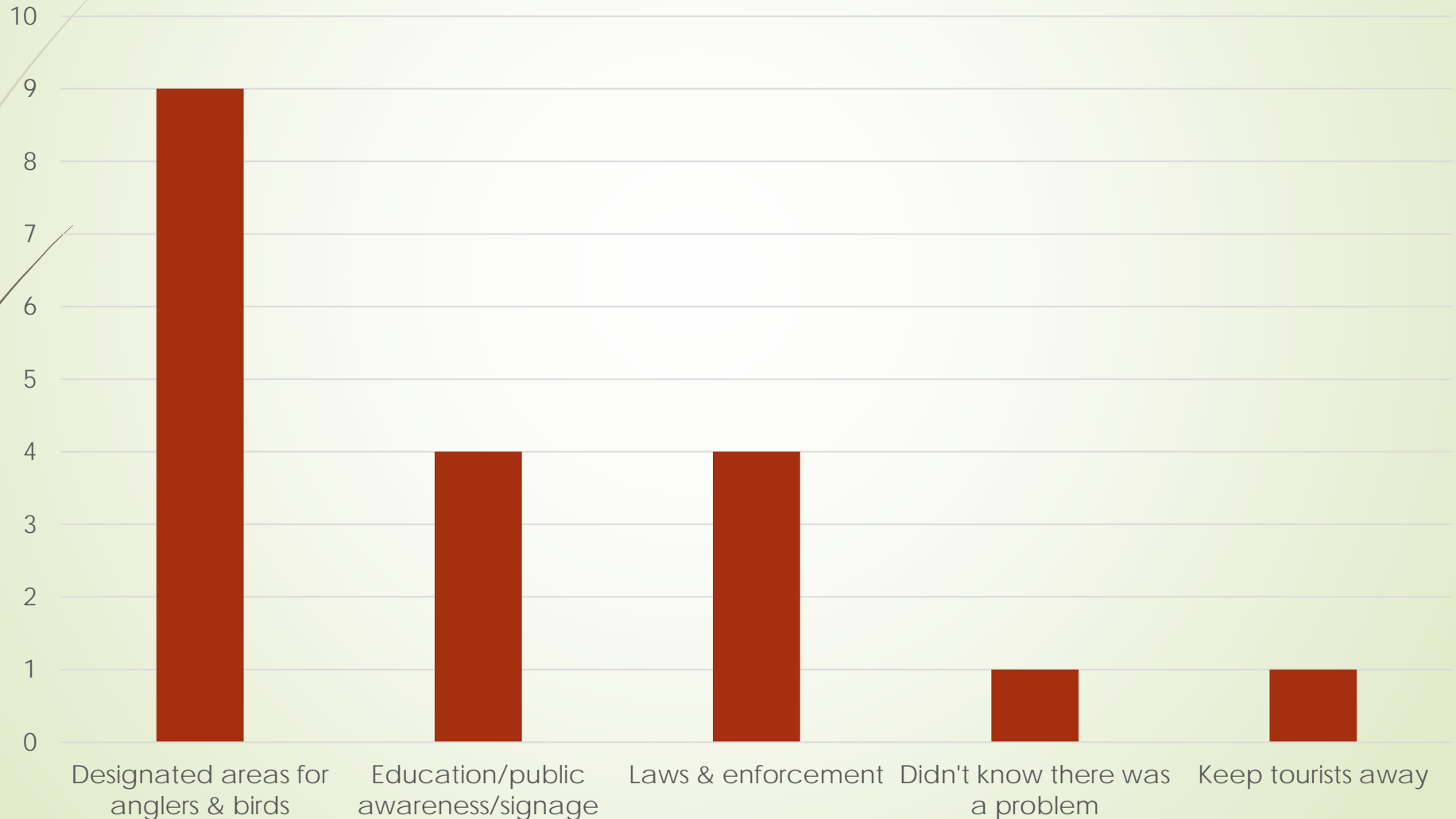
How could we communicate a dedicated high tide shorebird beach to walkers, anglers, photographers, birders and other users?
